Resolution of the
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to be more businesslike,
and

WHEREAS, the council believes that the production will be greater if
each councilman is paid on an hourly rate rather than a day rate,
and

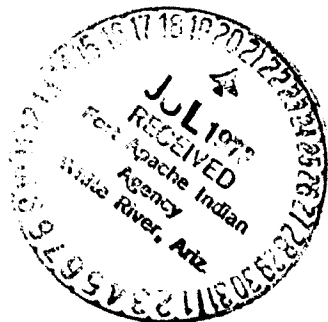
WHEREAS, it is necessary that councilmen be in attendance at 8:30 a.m.
and remain in attendance until close of business at 4:30 p.m.,
and

WHEREAS, the Chairman is directed to declare a fifteen-minute rest period
in the morning and in the afternoon for the comfort of the
council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the rate of pay for the council will be declared
\$5.00 for each full hour of duty on the council floor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the scheduled adjournment will be 12:00 p.m. and
the council will reconvene at 1:00 p.m. each Regular and Special
Council Meetings.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of
10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section
1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by
the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).
