## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that with the increased duties assigned to the Vice Chairman, that additional compensation should be offered for the duties, and

WHEREAS, the discussion of the Tribal Council set the opinion of the difference of \$2,000.00 between the Chairman and the Vice Chairman' salary.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Vice Chairman's salary is hereby established at \$13,000.00 per annum effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
