FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the tribe has constructed a Vocational School at Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, and

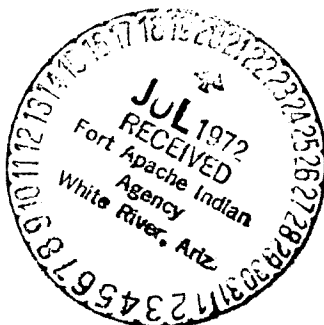
WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has agreed to loan the White Mountain Apache Tribe the sum of \$58,000.00, (EDA Project No. 08-1-00604), which sum is needed to pay the balance due and owing on said Vocational building.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized and directed to sign a promissory note in the amount of \$58,000.00 payable to the Economic Development Administration, said \$58,000.00 to be secured by the assignment of all the rents, profits and income from the Southwest Forest Industries McNary Lease or from any income received from any sublease of the lands covered by Indian lease.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1972 duly adopted by 10 for Oagains Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
