

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to obtain satisfactory water supply and waste disposal facilities for participants in the Mutual-Help Housing Program and other members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority and the Tribe have requested assistance under Public Law 36-121 in the installation of water and waste disposal facilities for Indian families in the Whiteriver townsite, and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service has offered to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement to supply these facilities under Public Law 36-121.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they hereby agree to the Memorandum of Agreement between the United States of America and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority and the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the north Whiteriver Townsite on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and the Chairman of the White Mountain Housing Authority be given the authority as of this day to approve said Memorandum of Agreement dated August 2, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (I) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1953 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1953, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
