


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ralph Aday, while serving for his country in the Armed Forces, was killed in action in World War II, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to memorialize his name and honor all other White Mountain Apache veterans who have served their country in time of war.

BE IT RESOLVED that Memorial Hall shall hereafter be named and known as ADAY HALL.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
