

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recognize and honor employees for their time in service to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council also desires to recognize and honor Council members for their time in service to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that such recognition will help to improve the morale of Council Members, employees and Tribal members.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council award Service pins to Tribal employees for 5, 10, 15, 20, and 25 years of service to the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council recognize all Council members by the award of a ring for their service on the Tribal Council, and to have pictures taken of each member for posting in a gallery in the Tribal Chambers, said pictures to show the dates the member served on the Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Advisory Committee is hereby authorized to monitor and supervise the above-award system.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and by-laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
