FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is a great success and of prime importance in the early development of our youth, and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program is of great benefit to the future education of the White Mountain Apache children.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached proposed budget for the continuation of the Head Start Program be approved.

The foregoing resolution was on September 18, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
