

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the group of the presiding bishops of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, a corporation sole, Cibecue, Arizona had a revocable permit to enter and occupy a certain parcel of land located at Cibecue, Arizona, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, a description of said land being on file at the Fort Apache Agency Office, Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the said revocable permit terminated on October 31, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to extend said period of October 31, 1971 until October 31, 1981.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency is hereby authorized to enter into a new revocable permit with the corporation of the presiding bishops of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, a corporation sole, Cibecue, Arizona from the 31st day of October, 1971 until the 31st day of October, 1981 or until sooner revoked.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the parcel of land containing approximately 0.425 acres is located in Cibecue, Arizona and that an accurate description of same is on file at the Fort Apache Agency Office, Whiteriver, Arizona to which description reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on September 18, 1972 duly adopted by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
