

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that there is a great need to advertise the new Sunrise Park and Ski Complex, and

WHEREAS, traffic should also be encouraged through Whiteriver to bring more business to Tribal Enterprises, and

WHEREAS, road directional signs effectively direct traffic through areas of interest to the traveling public.

BE IT RESOLVED that this Tribal Council authorize the painting, installation and lighting of a large two-sided road sign at Carrizo Junction at the Junction of State Highway 60 and 73 stating, "Short Cut Through Fort Apache and Whiteriver, (the Headquarters of the White Mountain Apache Tribe) to Sunrise Park Lodge and Ski Complex."

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
