RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in the past hunting and fishing privileges, on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, have been granted to non-members, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the granting of these permits should be forever estopped.

BE IT RESOLVED that hereafter there shall be no more additional hunting and fishing privileges granted to non-members.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
