RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Joe Dora has served the White Mountain Apache Tribe in many ways during the early years of our tourism development, and

WHEREAS, the council does understand that his private business interests and his dedication to the welfare of the Arizona outdoorsman could cause a conflict of interest, now that our tourism development into the operative stage.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the council fully agrees in the best interests of the Tribe, to relieve Mr. Joe Dora of his duties and obligations as Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Recreation Enterprise, Apache Business Enterprise and Sunrise Park Enterprise and all other committee or Board memberships, effective December 6, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
