RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested that the Secretary of the Interior not approve the "Salt River Water Association Agreement", and
- WHEREAS, in their expression it also requested funds be set aside for an independent study of the White Mountain Apache water requirements, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has been informed that Hans Walker has set aside \$50,000.00 in the Washington Office Budget for water requirement study, and
- WHEREAS, the need is greater on the Fort Apache Reservation to determine future need requirements.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it requests the use of the \$50,000.00 for a water requirement study upon their lands.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that they participate in the selection of the firm or organization to complete the study.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
