

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Western States Telephone Company serves the reservation,
and

WHEREAS, the Western States Telephone Company desires to upgrad and
expand their services to the reservation communities, and

WHEREAS, Permit Maps No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4 show the area to be
improved and expanded has been issued and approved by the
Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe that permission is given to the Western States Telephone
Company to expand the existing facilities on the existing
permits as recorded on maps on file in the Superintendent's
Office, No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Western States Telephone Company submit to
the Superintendent, after changes have been made, corrected
copies of the original permit maps.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adopted by a vote
of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1
(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the
Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
