

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the cutting expiration dates on the following described logging units expire on December 31, 1972:

Turkey Creek	H50C-1420-630
Ord Creek	H50C-1420-7046
Lame Deer	H50C-1420-6709
North Fork Spruce	H50C-1420-7411

and

WHEREAS, all of these logging units are under contract to the Fort Apache Timber Company, a tribal enterprise, and

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that the contract dates be extended due to extremely wet weather during 1972, and

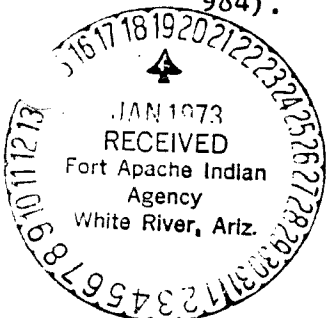
WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tribe to extend these dates to allow Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform other contract obligations, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Committee recommends approval of these extensions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe consents to extend the cutting expiration date to December 31, 1973 and the expiration date for other sale obligations to December 31, 1974 on the following contracts:

- Turkey Creek
- Ord Creek
- Lame Deer
- North Fork Spruce

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
