RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, U. S. Public Health Service has agreed to construct water and sewage disposal facilities for Project No. PH 73-219, Ten Unit Home Improvement, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and Project No. 73-218, Whiteriver Low-Rent Housing, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the U. S. Public Health Service by and between the U. S. Public Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority; such agreement having been read to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute the agreements for the construction of water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Project No. PH 73-219, Ten Unit Home Improvement; Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and Project No. 73-218, Whiteriver Low-Rent Housing, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to execute the agreements with the U. S. Public Health Service.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
