

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Manager of the Sunrise Motel is terminating his employment today, and

WHEREAS, this action leaves the Tribe in a serious situation in management and other employees at the hotel, and

WHEREAS, it is not in the best interest of the Tribe to let the resource remain idle.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that to protect their investment in the Sunrise Hotel that the Superintendent and the Sunrise Board of Directors are authorized to hire whatever management or other employees that are needed to keep the operation of the Hotel going.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Board of Directors of the Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise have full authority to act on behalf of the Tribe and to take all actions necessary to see that the resource is protected and the hotel managed in the most desirable way possible.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
