

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to hire a Chief of Police to be a Tribal employee and operate the Tribal Law Enforcement Program, and

WHEREAS, this position was advertised in December and also in January, and

WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee and the Tribal Council reviewed the resumes of the four applicants, and

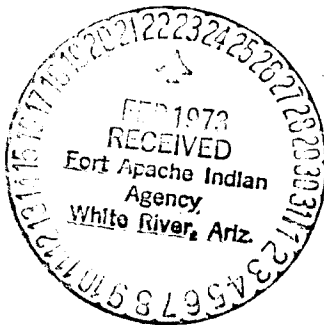
WHEREAS, Roy Kenneth Douros was selected as being the most qualified.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Roy Kenneth Douros be hired effective February 8, 1973 to be the Tribal Chief of Police.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to enter into a contract with Roy Kenneth Douros which is to be satisfactory to the Superintendent and the Law and Order Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the job sheet published in the advertisement be a part of and attached to the contract for the Chief of Police.

The foregoing resolution was on February 8, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
