RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN ANACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is low on operating capital, and
- WHEREAS, there are payments past due for construction work done on Phase II on Sunrise Park, and
- WHEREAS, reimbursements due from Economic Development Administration have been slow and payments need to be made to contractors, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has a Time Certificate Deposit in the amount of \$500,000.00 that can be used to secure interim financing for Economic Development Administration Projects.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and the Treasurer (Administrative Manager) be authorized and directed to secure loans or loan in the amount not to exceed \$300,000.00 and pledge the unencumbered portion of Time Certificate Dep sit No. 47835 as security for said loans or loan and that they be further authorized to complete any documents necessary for this transaction.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any reimbursements from Economic Development Administration not be commingled with other tribal funds and upon receipt of said reimbursements that it be applied to pay off any loans secured by this Time Certificate Deposit No. 47835.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
