

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

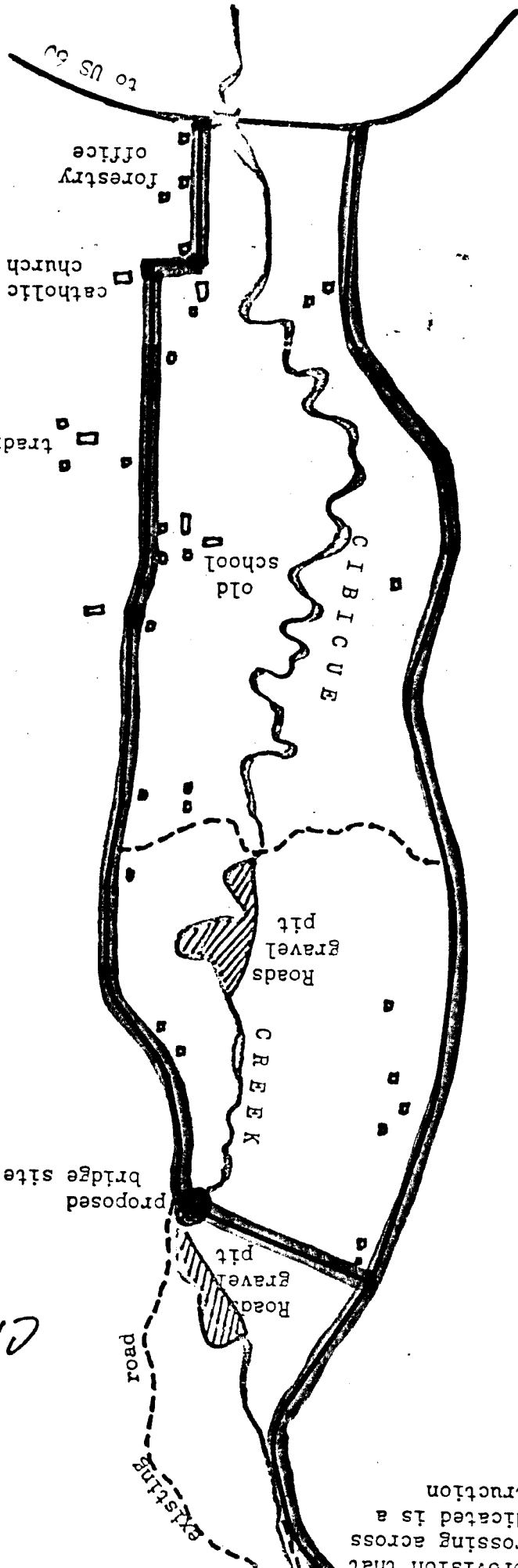
- WHEREAS, on the Cibecue Loop Road of north Cibecue has previously been approved by the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, due to survey difficulties and other reasons, the proposed alignment on the Cibecue Loop was changed, and
- WHEREAS, under the new alignment, a bridge is to be constructed on the present crossing of Cibecue Creek, and
- WHEREAS, the alignment from this crossing to Salt Creek Crossing is to be constructed into a school bus route, and
- WHEREAS, a bridge is to be constructed on the Salt Creek Crossing.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the new road alignment is accepted.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that permission to survey and contract is hereby approved.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the new alignment will be as per the attached drawing.

The foregoing resolution was on March 8, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

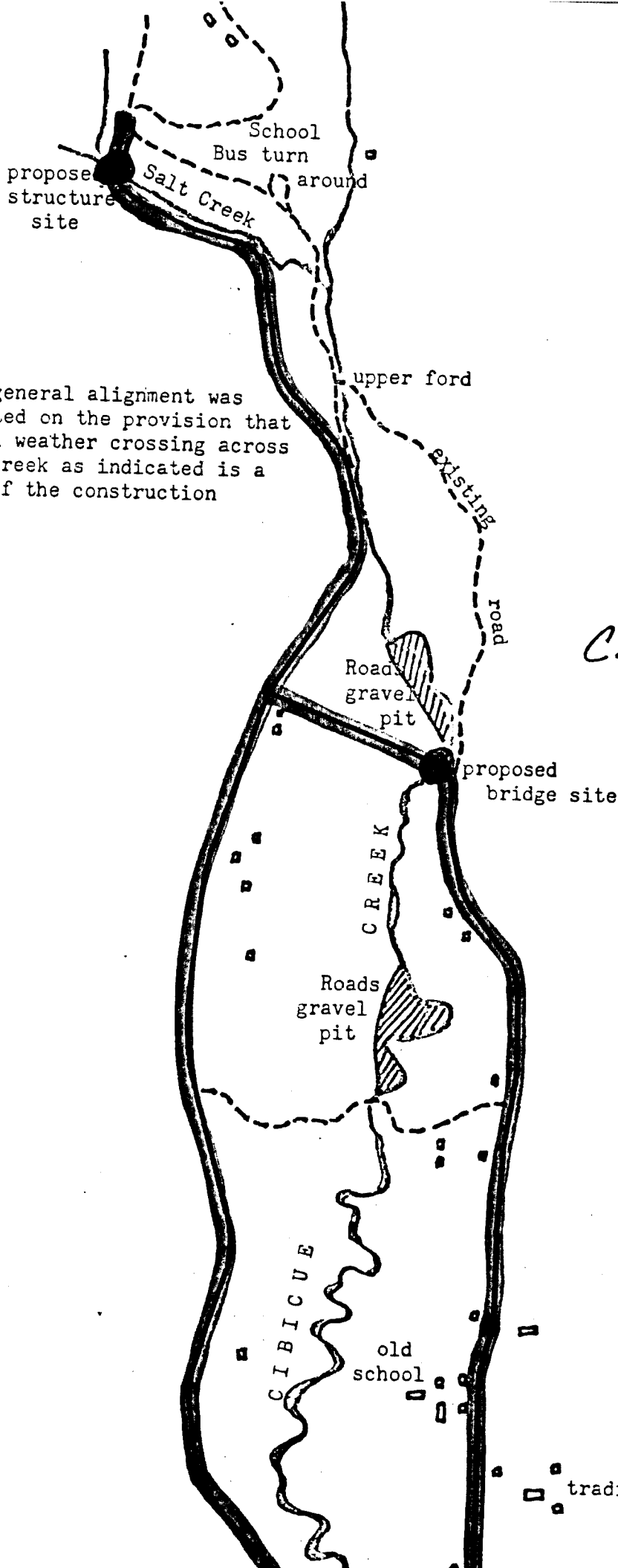
