WHEREAS, the operating enterprises must contribute to the Central Office for the expense incurred in bookkeeping and administration, and


WHEREAS, these charges have not been revised for a period of five (5) years, and


WHEREAS, listed below is the proposed charges to be included in the 1973-1974 budgets.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Administrative Officer assess to each operating enterprise, the amount listed above for operating charges of the Tribal Business Office for the year 1973-1974 operating budget.

The foregoing resolution was on March 8, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
