

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribe has encouraged individual members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enter into business, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Clinton Kessay, Sr. has applied through the Revolving Loan Fund for a loan, and
- WHEREAS, the loan secured is for the construction of a laundromat, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to a long term lease to Mr. Kessay on the southwest subdivision, Block 3, Lots 7 & 8, Whiteriver townsite.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Clinton Kessay, Sr. be granted a twenty-five (25) year lease for a business, a laundromat, in the above-described area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tribal fees be waived for the first five (5) year period and tribal fees to be subject to evaluation of an assessment after the first five (5) year period if the tribe desires.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to sign the lease.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
