WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads, request permission to construct the Diamond Creek Bridge, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees and accepts the recommendation of the Roads Department's request.

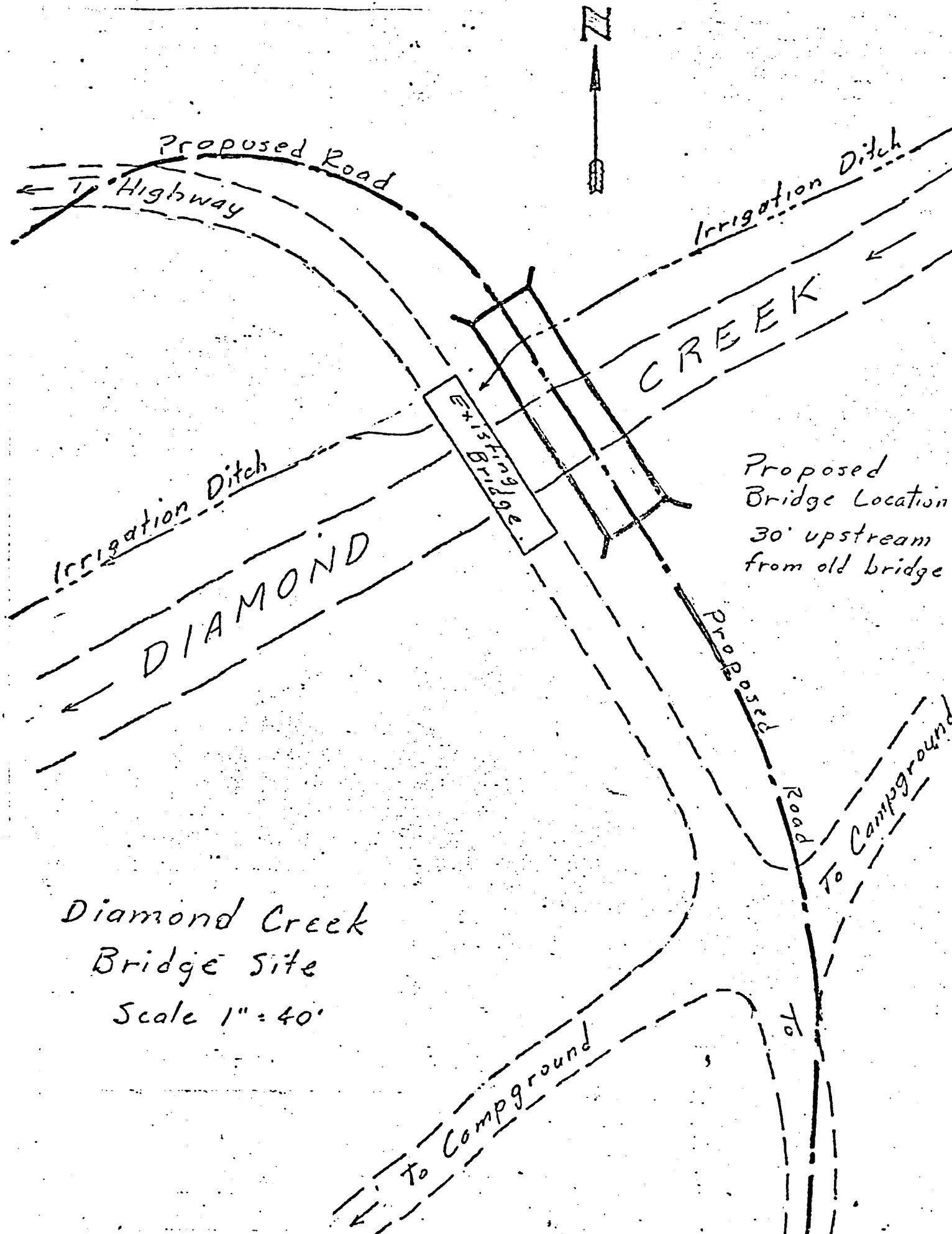
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission is hereby granted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads to construct the Diamond Creek Bridge.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
