## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Maintenance Department request permission to have Contractor make approximately 900 tons of cold mix and 7,000 yards of ABC 1" crushed gravel, to be made in John Bourke Pit, north of Whiteriver where equipment is now located for another project, and
- WHEREAS, all the material will be used to patch the Arizona State Highway roads on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council accepts the request from the Arizona State Highway Department and waive the royalty clause on the material as it will be used for reservation road maintenance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission is hereby granted to the Arizona State Highway Maintenance Department District 7, Show Low, Arizona to have said material made.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
