

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, during the Cedar Creek and Cibecue floods in September and October of 1972, the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority assisted the Indian Health Service, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service furnished the necessary materials, and the Utility Authority furnished labor, equipment, and supervision to repair the damage, and

WHEREAS, the United States Public Health Service desires to reimburse the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority for the labor, equipment, and supervision in the amount of \$1,100.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be directed to bill the U. S. Public Health Service and accept the reimbursement for the \$1,100.00.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
