

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 72-118 adopted on August 2, 1972, granted and approved residential leases for Lydo Harvey, along with other tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the last "Resolve" in Resolution No. 72-118 states that if the FHA loans were not approved within 18 days from the date of the resolution, the lease and approval of right to mortgage the leasehold improvements would automatically terminate, and

WHEREAS, the 180 day period for Lydo Harvey has expired and FHA has not completed and approved all the necessary documents.

BE IT RESOLVED that a 90-day extension is hereby granted to FHA to complete all the necessary documents for the construction of a home for Lydo Harvey.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
