

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the vehicle now being used by the Vice Chairman has exceeded many miles and is unsafe for travelling, and

WHEREAS, it will cost a lot of money for repairs.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum not to exceed \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States to purchase a new automobile for use of the Vice-Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
