

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the General Accounting Office is observing total community programs,
and

WHEREAS, they would like to hire some White Mountain Apache Interviewers
to assist in conducting an information study, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has no objection to the survey and questionnaire.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that
the General Accounting Office is hereby permitted to conduct the
proposed study, hire and train White Mountain Apache Interviewers
for the benefit of the community evaluation.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of
7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1
(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the
Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
