

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise is charged with the responsibility of regulating hunting and fishing by non-members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 1973, the White Mountain Recreation Board of Directors met and recommends to the Tribal Council a schedule on season and bag limits on elk hunting, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors recommended the season dates as November 24 through December 2, 1973 for non-members; 300 any elk permits, 100 bulls only permits.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that this recommendation recommended by the Board of Directors be approved.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
