

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the University of Arizona has conducted experiments on forest lands on the Reservation for a number of years and

WHEREAS, these should be an on going study plots so the maximum information on forest practices can be obtain.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that additional work on these existing study plots may be made as long as the results from these studies are available to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
