

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to have a more extensive part in their Law Enforcement Program, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to enter into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, this contract would be for the amount of \$51,000.00, and

WHEREAS, this contract be facilitated by tribal management and law enforcement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman be given authority to negotiate and sign all necessary documents to consummate this law enforcement contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract be in effect from July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1974.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
