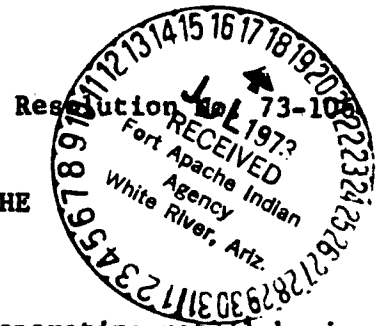


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION



WHEREAS, certain members of the tribe who are now operating retail business establishments objected to Lee Mercantile Company remodeling and enlarging its present store in Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to encourage the White Mountain Apaches to enter into business endeavors, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to assist said White Mountain Apaches in every way possible so that the said business ventures will be a success.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 73-99 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Johnny Lee and Mr. Charles Montgomery be advised of the tribe's actions.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
