RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Law and Order Department desires to make a proposal for the Tribal Police Department to receive funds from the Revenue Sharing Program for upgrading the Tribal Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the overall proposal submitted will be for the amount of \$46,650.00, and

WHEREAS, this proposal be facilitated by the Tribal Law and Order Enforcement Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman give authority and sign all necessary documents to consummate this Law enforcement proposal under the White Mountain Apache Tribe Revenue Sharing Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposal take effect from July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1974.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 4 for, 3 against and 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

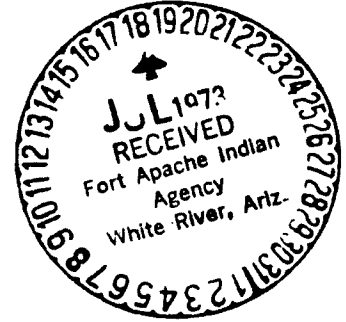
