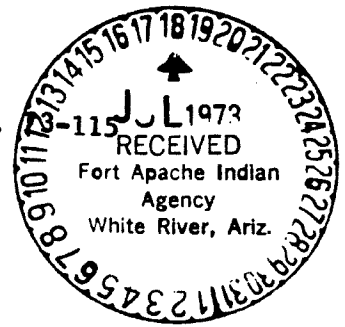

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Owen Copeland has had long years of experience in the hotel business, recreation and tourism business, and
- WHEREAS, said Owen Copeland possesses great ability and supervisory keenness in these said fields, and
- WHEREAS, he has worked in a supervisory capacity for the White Mountain Apaches during the past three years, and
- WHEREAS, he has served the White Mountain Apaches in an outstanding manner, and
- WHEREAS, he has trained Apaches for managerial positions and is dedicated to improve the standard of living of the White Mountain Apaches, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Economic Development Administration that a General Manager should be appointed to supervise the Sunrise Motel and Ski Run Complex, and
- WHEREAS, it is the unanimous judgment of the Tribal Council that Mr. Owen Copeland is the best qualified person that could be found to fill this position.
- BE IT RESOLVED that effective July 11, 1973, Owen Copeland is hereby appointed as General Manager of the Sunrise Motel and Ski Run Complex and the White Mountain Apache Enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the management of both the Sunrise Motel and Ski Run Complex be advised of the Tribal Council's action.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
