WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Tribal Law and Order Committee state that Mr. Douros has done an excellent job since he has been here, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that Mr. Roy K. Douros is a very capable officer.


BE IT RESOLVED that the contract for the Chief of Police for the Whiteriver Police Department is approved for the period beginning February 12, 1973 and ending April 30, 1975 at an annual salary of \$10,500.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on the anniversary date of each year of the contract, that the Law and Order Committee negotiate for a raise of pay, if any, with Mr. Douros and make its recommendations to the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized, on behalf of the council, to sign said contract.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
