

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on August 2, 1962, by Resolution No. 62-69, Western States Telephone Company was granted a right-of-way to construct a micro-wave tower and a central office building at Smith Park (Hawley Lake), and

WHEREAS, this right-of-way was granted for a ten-year period, subject to renewal for a like term, beginning on the 1st day of September, 1972 with a rental rate of \$50.00 per year, and

WHEREAS, Western States Telephone Company has exercised their option to renew for the additional ten-year period, and have furnished a new appraisal covering the site.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the new appraisal rate in the amount of \$1,500.00 per year is hereby accepted and shall be payable in advance beginning on the 1st day of September, 1972, and on the same date yearly thereafter during the remaining term of the right-of-way.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 2 abst. 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
