RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise desires to move into the old Roads Shop areas, and

WHEREAS, the transfer from the Bureauof Indian Affairs is in progress,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council grants permission to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise to move into and utilize the old Roads Shop area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, for the use of the old Roads Shop area, be assessed \$300.00 monthly plus their own payment of utilities, insurance, fencing and maintenance.

PE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is authorized to make improvements or modification in said property at their own expense.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
