RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy in the Agency Office of Employment Assistance, and

WHEREAS, Irma Fall is employed in this office as a clerk, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires that its people be given opportunity for advancement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Irma Fall be given an opportunity for advancement in this office with additional training and job respectively.

The foregoing resolution was on September 25, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
