

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need for a Deputy Assessor to be located in Whiteriver in order to serve the people of the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$1200.00 is budgeted as and for the salary for the Deputy Assessor to be loczted at Whiteriver, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one of the qualifications of the Deputy Assessor be to speak and understand the Apache language, preferably a member of the tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
