RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the grazing permits issued in 1959 to the associations will expire on May 1, 1974, and
- WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 31, the Tribal Council must re-assess the grazing fees and the length of the permits, and
- WHEREAS, it is the present desires of the council to further study the equity of range utilization.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the grazing permits issued under Ordinance 31, May 1, 1969 are to be extended until May 1, 1975.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in this period of one year, the Tribal Council will make a detailed evaluation of the equities and uses of the tribal range resource.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent issue a one year revocable permit to each association under the same terms and conditions as the permit that is expiring.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
