

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to cooperate and assist the Arizona State Highway Department in road maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the Highway Department needs to stockpile cinders for use on icy roads as a public safety factor on Reservation State Highway roads, and

WHEREAS, the tribe is agreeable with the Highway Department getting the cinders from the Cooley Mountain Pit, next to Lester Oliver's residence on Highway 73.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the State Highway Department be permitted to take cinders from the above-named pit as needed for application on the icy roads for public safety.

The foregoing resolution was on November 8, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
