

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Community has requested that the Cedar Creek Pow Wow be an annual event to take place on the first pay day of June each year, and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Community also request that the second pay day weekend in July be reserved for community activities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Cedar Creek Community is hereby authorized to hold an annual Cedar Creek Pow Wow on the first pay day weekend in June of each year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Cedar Creek Community is hereby granted permission to hold the rodeo and other community activities on the weekend of the second pay period for July of each year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Cedar Creek Community should notify the Tribal Council in writing ninety (90) days prior to each event.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
