

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need for a steady, reliable flow of tree seedlings to replant the wildfire burns and clear cuts, and

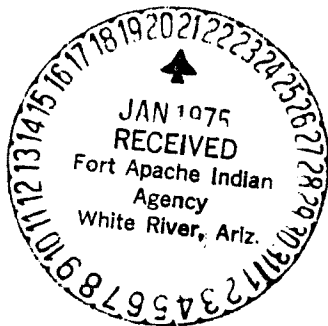
WHEREAS, the greenhouse system of growing containerize tree stock is the only method suitable, and

WHEREAS, a suitable location for the greenhouse is at McNary, due to the availability of low salt water, and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Livestock Association and Land Board have approved the location.

BE IT RESOLVED that approximately one and one-half acres (1½) be set aside just west of the McNary Forestry Station for the Fort Apache Agency to use for a greenhouse.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
