

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Native American Programs was declared on Advanced Action Agency, and

WHEREAS, we received \$20,000.00 to develop and run our own training and technical assistance program during the program year, May 1, 1974, and

WHEREAS, we have received word that this money will not be available to us this coming program year, and

WHEREAS, we would like to continue to control our own training monies.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby request that the Native American Program budget \$20,000.00 to provide training and technical assistance for Fiscal Year 1975-76.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (c) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
