

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is currently without legal counsel,  
and

WHEREAS, the water hearing on February 18, 1975, the White Mountain Apache  
Tribe will not be represented.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe  
that the Bureau of Indian Affairs and Area Director lend assistance  
to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for legal representation at the  
water hearing on February 18, 1975.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Miss Kathy Rihr be assigned from the Solicitor's  
Office to represent the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 12, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of  
8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache  
Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) and (f)  
of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe  
June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
