RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a Tribal airplane hangar near the runway at the Whiteriver airport, and
- WHEREAS, this building is a safety hazard as it is too close to the runway, and
- WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee, after discussing the problem, recomends that this building be moved to another site at the airport, and
- WHEREAS, the Branch of Forestry, Fort Apache Indian Agency, also feels that this safety hazard should be moved.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Branch of Forestry is authorized by the Tribal Council to see that this building is moved to a new location south of the Astro Aviation lease site.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the existing concrete slab and stemwalls will be removed to make the old hangar site safe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 27, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Triba, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Triba, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
