

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the request of the White Mountain Apache Rodeo Association composed of 64 members, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the White Mountain Apache Rodeo Association organize and operate under the National Rodeo Cowboy Association Rules and Regulations, and

WHEREAS, the Council understands that membership fees will be charged annually to the Association members, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Fair Rodeo Association may be members also of the White Mountain Apache Rodeo Association.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Rodeo Association be formed and operated under the rules and regulations of the National Rodeo Cowboy Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the recognition date of December 31st each year that was established under Resolution No. 75-3 be rescinded and the date of December 31st each year be recognized as an award and achievement night for the White Mountain Apache Rodeo Association.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 75-3 be rescinded in its entirety.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
