RESOLUTION OF THE • WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is contracting for the Tribal Work Experience Program with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Work Experience Program is to assist the needy people in developing initiative and improve work habits, and
- WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that physically able welfare constitutuents should be required to participate in the Tribal Work Experence Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all Heads of Household who are applicants for general assistance be required to participate in the Tribal Work Experience Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is also the opinion of the Tribal Council that by taking this action, individual participants will be more greatly benefitted by being employed and by having their skills utilized and developed.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Tribal Work Experience Program make every effort to utilize each able-bodied applicant for productive program work.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council believes that the objectives of the Tribal Work Experience Program can be met more effectively by including in the contract the general assistance grant for all eligible members of the household.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
