

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered with interest the caseload in the Superior Court of Navajo County, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has discussed and is in agreement with the establishment of a new Superior Court Division, and

WHEREAS, the Council discussed that it is familiar with John Taylor's qualifications.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they strongly recommend to Governor Raul Castro that John Taylor receive the appointment for the new division of the Superior Court, State of Arizona, County of Navajo.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council endorses John Taylor, presently a Navajo County Attorney, for this position on the basis of a long association and friendship.

The foregoing resolution was on April 9, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and by-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
