WHEREAS, Roger Lupe had been negotiating with the Small Business Administration for the purchase of the Laundromat, and

WHEREAS, Wesley Loas, the former owner, agrees and consents to the purchase and the transfer.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Laundromat business lease in the name of Wesley Loas be transferred to Roger Lupe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the transfer be on the same terms and conditions as it was in the original lease.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
