

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Sunrise Park Resort Complex, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Sunrise Park Resort Complex recommended approval by the Tribal Council of a General and Operating Budget for the Resort Complex from May 1, 1975 to April 30, 1976, a budget of proposed Capital Expenditures, and Summer Program Budget, and said budgets have been prepared and recommended in accordance with the Plan of Operation for the Enterprise.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the budget for the General Operating Expenses for the operation of the Sunrise Park Resort Complex from May 1, 1975 to April 30, 1976 in the amount of \$1,022, ~~8~~1.00 and Capital Expenditures in the amount of \$195,525.00 are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Supplement Budget for the 1975 Summer Camp Program in the amount of \$36,368.00 is Hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1975 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
